# 900 years of History...

Set in the heart of winegrowing Burgundy, the Château du Clos de Vougeot is a unique historical landmark where a passion for the terroir lives side by side with secular tradition. Around 1110, the monks of Cîteaux Abbey established a farm estate here midway between Beaune and Dijon.

Buildings were put up for making wine, and soon the land was surrounded by a three kilometer-long wall. The courtyard was created by the addition of the Renaissance wings in 1551, transforming the wine farm into a château. Today, if the Château du Clos de Vougeot has no vines of its own and no longer produces nor sells wine, it remains a potent symbol of almost one thousand years of Burgundy's history.

**1098**

Foundation of *Abbaye de Cîteaux*.

Between **1110** and **1115**

The monks establish a wine estate at Vougeot on land donated by the faithful.

**1170**

Construction of the Great Cellar.

**1200**

First reference to the wall surrounding the Clos de Vougeot.

Between **1470** and **1480**

Construction of the *Cuverie* and two wine-presses.

**1551**

Construction of the Renaissance abbatial residence.

**1791**

The Château and vineyard confiscated and sold as 'state property' by the Revolutionary Government.

**1934**

Creation of the *Confrérie des Chevaliers du Tastevin*.

**2015**

The Climats of Burgundy classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

**2019**

First World Championship of Eggs in Meurette
